Page 4

Equipment Specifications – Cues, paragraph (d), change second sentence to read:

The cue tip on break cues must be made of leather with no non-leather materials added to the contacting surface.

Page 34

Add the following sentence to the end of Rule 1.40(d):

Second **and subsequent** violations during a match: loss of game.

Page 73

Add the following section and ruling to the Applied Rulings:

APPLIED RULINGS: EQUIPMENT SPECIFICATIONS

Cues (also Rule 1.4, Cue Requirements)

For the purposes of the paragraph (d) restrictions on the composition of the tip for a break cue, any cue used to perform a break shot will be considered a break cue. If the cue used is the player's normal playing cue, it does not need to be removed from play, although it may not be used for further break shots.

Page 78

Applied Ruling 1.3, second paragraph "Rule 1.3(e)": delete the first sentence.
